## Year 8 Cycle 1 Assessments

I am writing to let you know that your child will soon be completing Cycle 1 assessments in all core subjects. The assessments will begin on Monday 13 October and take place over a 1-week period.

These assessments will provide us with important information about your child's attainment and allow us to address any knowledge gaps and provide support to those who need it.

Your child will be supported with revision in both subject lessons and during advisory time, however it is important that they are preparing at home too. Please find attached a list of revision topics that your child needs to be familiar with for the assessments. The knowledge tested will be a combination year 7 and year 8 content so far. All examinations will take place in classrooms during usual lessons.

After the assessments, you will receive a report with your child's score, as well as the average score for all students who completed the assessment in the Academy. The report will have a guide to help families to interpret the information.
