## Re: End of Term Arrangements and Return to Academy Information

As we approach the end of another successful term at Dixons Newall Green Academy, we would like to update you on what students have been up to, as well as provide some essential information for the return to academy after the holidays.

Chinese New Year: on Thursday, 15 February, we held our Year 7 Chinese New assembly and the judging of our Dragon Challenge in partnership with Swire Chinese Language Centre Manchester. It was an amazing showcase of our students' creativity, commitment and resilience and the culmination of weeks of hard work from all Advisory Groups.

### **Lockers and Cashless Payment:**

Upon return, new lanyards and cashless cards will be issued to students (there has been a delay in handing these out this halfterm due to technical issues). These will link to your ParentPay account and facilitate purchases during break time and Family Dining. Students are required to carry these at all times.

Additionally, for students who have lost their locker keys, replacements will be provided. We strongly advise making copies of these keys to avoid future inconveniences. Please note, any subsequent replacements will incur a charge of £5.
