School Uniform: Academic Year 2026-27

Dear families,

As we approach the next half-term and the summer period, I am writing to remind you of our expectations regarding school uniform at Dixons Newall Green Academy.

At our school, uniform plays a vital role in promoting a culture of high expectations, equality and pride. When all students wear their uniform correctly, it helps ensure a calm, focused and purposeful environment for learning.

Our expectations

With your support all students are expected to:

- Wear full school uniform every day, including correct footwear
- Ensure uniform is always worn neatly and appropriately
- Arrive to school fully equipped and ready to learn

School uniform	P.E. Kit
• Students must wear full length, tailored black trousers (Trousers must be straight and must not be Lycra, denim or similar stretchy material. (No jeans, tracksuit bottoms, leggings, flares, yoga pants, cargo, canvas or linens). • Students must wear a plain, white polo shirt. • Students must wear the academy jumper in either green, grey or black*. • Hijabs, scarves, turbans, crowns and top knots for religious reasons must be plain black, grey or green (as above for the academy jumper) and must have no additional design/ embellishment. • Footwear must be sensible and entirely black. Laces must be plain black. All footwear must be flat. Boots are not allowed. No colourful logos allowed on the footwear. • Socks should be plain black or white, decoration such as frills or bows or other decoration on socks are not permitted. • The academy varsity jacket is optional.	• Students must wear a plain, white polo shirt or a plain, white round neck t-shirt. • Students must wear the academy zipped training top*. • Students must wear the academy jogging bottoms*. • Students must wear either the academy jogging bottoms or the academy PE shorts with plain black leggings or skins underneath • Students must wear suitable sports trainers. High tops and other fashion trainers are not allowed. • Socks should be plain black or white, decoration such as frills or bows or other decoration on socks are not permitted.
	Optional P.E. Kit
	• Students may wear the academy P.E. shorts under their academy jogging bottoms.
	Other
	• Students can wear a suitable plain watch (not a smart watch). • Students can wear one set of small, round studs only. • New piercing must be removed or replaced with a clear retainer. • Make up, if worn, should be entirely discreet. • Nail varnish, gel or acrylic nails are not allowed. • No extreme hair styles such as shaved patterns or stripes. Hair should not be unnatural in colour. • Students who choose to wear false lashes that are excessive will be expected to remove them. • Students will be provided with a lanyard, name badge and key for their locker which they must wear at all times.



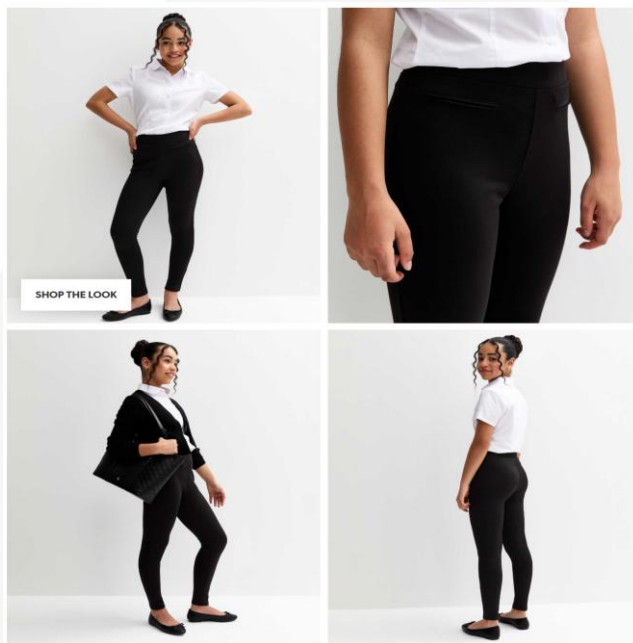
*The academy jumper, academy P.E. zipped training top and academy jogging bottoms can all be purchased from Debonair Schoolwear.

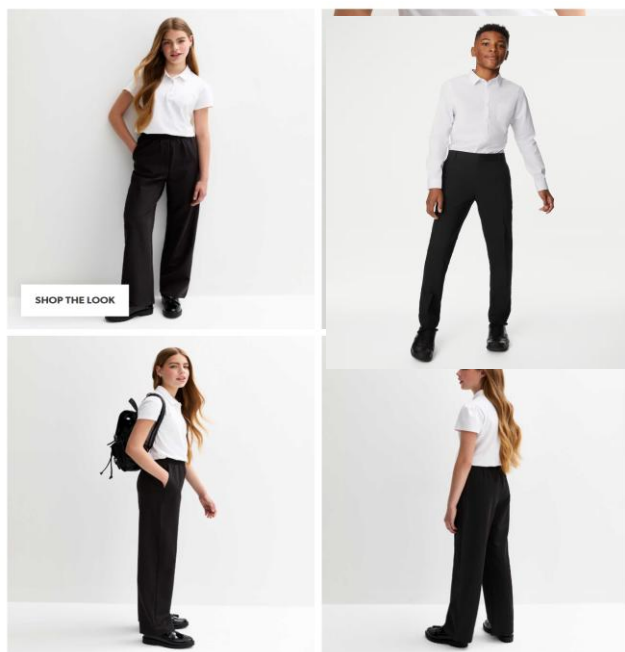

Additional Information

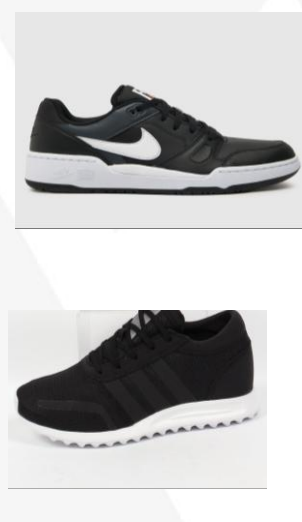
Trousers on the left are smart with a wider leg style. These are accepted. Trousers on the right that are tight fitting, a Lycra material or flares are not allowed.





Shoes

When in school uniform (not P.E. uniform) traditional school shoes or all black trainers (as shown on the left) are allowed. Any trainers that are not full black, for example black and white (shown on the right) are not allowed when students are in school uniform.



When students are in their P.E. Kit, trainers do not need to be plain black but must have a sports sole and not a flat sole. Flat sole, fashion trainers are not allowed as they are not safe to wear when playing sports.
