At Dixons, we always talk about climbing the mountain to university or a real alternative. Climbing Rivington Pike will help students to better understand that mission, a feat that relies on determination, teamwork and friendships.

Expedition

Rivington Pike is one of the best viewpoints in the North West England. At 363 metres high, it is the most westerly high point of Winter Hill in the West Pennine Moors. If the weather is clear, visitors can see sights such as Blackpool Tower, the Isle of Man and even the Lake District fells.

The expedition is **free for all**. Students will not need to bring any spending money.
