Dear families,

We would like to offer an amazing opportunity for your son / daughter to attend a 2-night, 3-day residential at the Outward Bound Centre, Ullswater, Lake District. The residential will take place in **March 2026**.

At Dixons Newall Green we are committed to developing the character and personal qualities of our students. This residential will encourage them to take risks, see failure as essential for success and develop confidence and resilience. Residentials such as these forge friendships and memories that will last a lifetime.

Purpose

The purpose of this residential is to help students live beyond their comfort zone and help them to become more well-rounded young people, destined to make a special contribution to the world we live and share. We hope that this residential will:

- Increase awareness of their own skills and abilities
- Improve confidence and self-belief
- Develop resilience and determination
- Increase knowledge and concern for the natural environment.

The Location

The Outward Bound Centre is set in 18 acres of woodland, at the heart of Wordsworth country. The centre is located on the north shore of the Lake Ullswater in the Lake District, overlooking the picturesque Lakeland fells.

Activities

During your son / daughter's stay at the centre, they will take part in a range of activities that will stretch and challenge them. Some of the activities **might** include:

- The infamous 'jog and dip'
- Ghyll scrambling
- Kayaking and canoeing
- Abseiling
- Visiting the spectacular Aira Force Waterfall
- Climbing a mountain
- Campfire and evening activities

Costs

Prior to sending out this letter, we have successfully applied for charitable funding and subsidies to significantly bring down the cost of the expedition which would normally cost more than £550 per person. With these deductions, we can now offer this expedition at £200 per person.
